Behaviour Policy- Traffic Light System

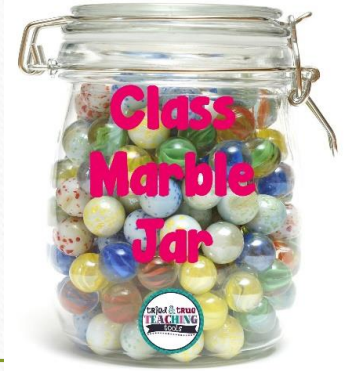
Every day, each child will begin on **green**. If they break the Code of Conduct, they will be given a verbal warning and will be moved onto **amber**.

Should the behaviour continue, they will move to red and be sent to the phase leader (Miss Dulay).

However, if a child demonstrates improved behaviour after being placed on amber, they have the opportunity to move back to green later in the day.



Rewards



Each child belongs to a house group and can earn individual house points for producing high-quality work or actively participating in class discussions.

Golden Time is awarded weekly as a class reward for positive behaviour and teamwork.

In addition, each class has a marble jar. Marbles are earned based on overall class behaviour, and once the jar reaches 30 marbles, the class will choose a treat as a reward.

Hunstanton - Summer term

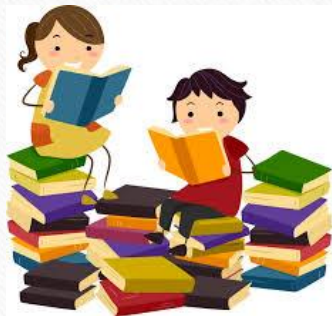


Trips can be withdrawn if a child's behaviour may pose a risk to themselves or others.

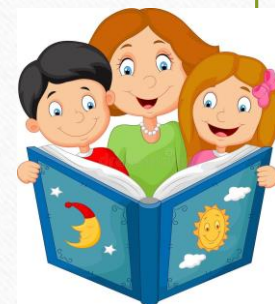
Mental Maths and Spelling tests will take place **every Friday**.

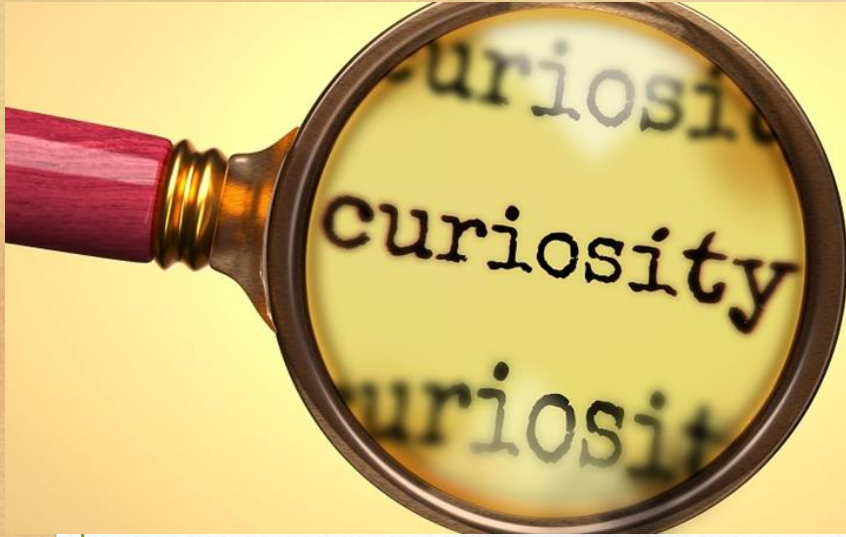
