Uniform



- Red jumper/cardigan
- Grey/black trousers (no belts)
- Grey skirt/pinafore
- Black shoes – **NO TRAINERS NO LACES**

- **PE KIT**
- **October – bring black plimsolls in a named bag to keep in school.** Children then come dressed to school in black joggers/leggings and a plain white T-shirt with their red uniform jumper from home. PE day TBC
- **May – bring kit into school to change at school**
- **NO jewelry must be worn for PE**
- Spare change of clothes in case of accidents
- **Uniforms will get dirty** – this will show parents that the children have been having fun!

Punctuality



- Morning Session **8.30 – 11.30**
- Afternoon session **12.15 – 3.15**
- Once settled, the children are dropped off at the door. If your child is still struggling to settle then staff will speak to you regarding shorter sessions or coming in for a few minutes to settle them.
- Doors will be closed at **8.40**. If you arrive after this time then you will need to take your child around to the office and register them there. If your child is absent for any reason please ring school and inform them.

- Milk and fruit is given at snack time
- Children all need to bring a bottle of water with them everyday LABELLED WITH THEIR NAME **in a bottle with a sports cap.**
- The children are encouraged to help themselves to their water bottles.

The Curriculum

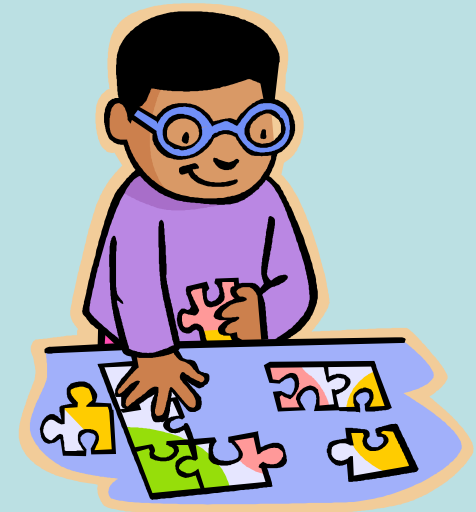
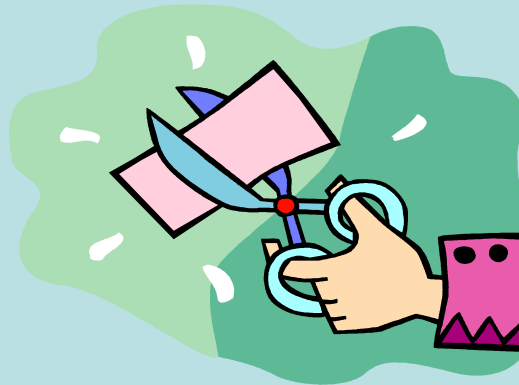


- The Foundation Stage Curriculum is taught through structured **play based** activities.

Literacy

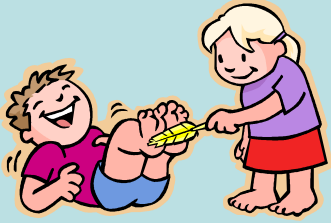
- Children will be able to take home library books once a week.

- These book are for you to share with your child and encourage talk.



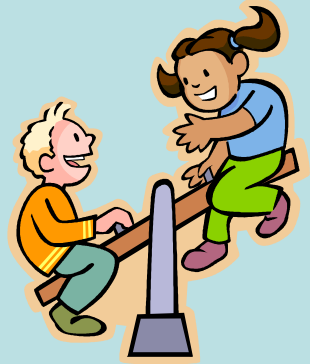
Helping at home

- Bringing in 'Show and Tell' items from home to talk about at school.

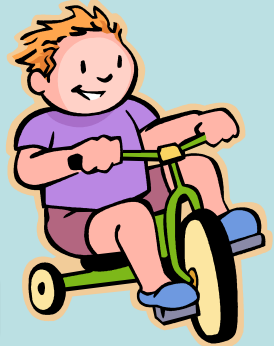




Outdoor Learning



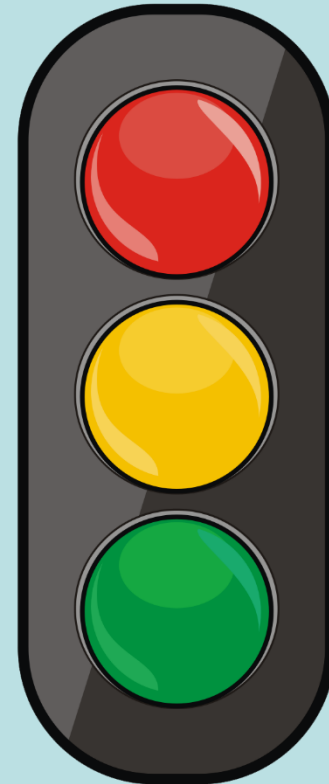
Being outdoors has a positive impact on children's sense of well-being and helps all aspects of children's development. It offers opportunities for doing things in different ways and on different scales than when indoors.

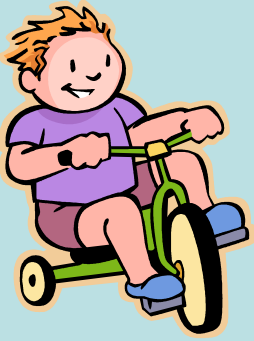


- **We will be taking the children out in all weather.**

First Aid & Medical Forms

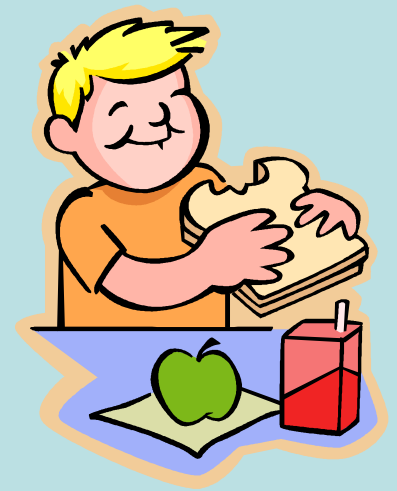
- Inform teachers if your child has any medical needs.

- If your child receives first aid at school from an incident that has happened at school, an email will be sent to your personal email address. This will inform you of the incident and the treatment given.
- Please do ensure that your email address is correct in the office.
- If your child has an injury to their head or face then you will receive a phone call as well as an email.





Nut Free School

- Please ensure any food you bring into school is **NUT FREE**
There are children in school with severe nut allergies
- Chocolate spread in packed lunches must be **NUT FREE**
- **Birthday treats** –Healthy treats.
- **MEDICAL CONCERNS**
Please inform the class teacher if your child has any long term medical conditions if you have not already done so.
