

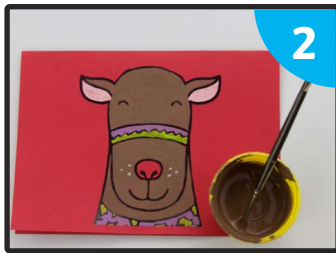
Handprint Rudolph Christmas Card

You will need:

- Rudolph Card Template
- Small Red Pom Pom
- Brown Paint
- Paintbrush
- Felt Tip Pens
- 2 pieces of A4 coloured card
- Plate or Tray for Paint
- PVA glue
- Scissors



In preparation, print the Rudolph template onto a piece of coloured card. Fold along the dotted line, then lay the card horizontal and flat ready for painting.



Now, colour in Rudolph's face using either paint or felt tip pens.



To create Rudolph's bright red nose, stick on a red pom-pom, using PVA glue.



Now, make Rudolph's antlers! To do this, use the paint brush to cover your left hand in brown paint. Then carefully print your hand on to the spare piece of card. Repeat this with your right hand, then leave to dry.



Once dry, use scissors to cut out both handprints.



Now, stick both handprints onto the top of Rudolph's head, so that the thumbs are on the inside. To do this, turn the handprints over, so that the painted side is facing down. Then, spread a little glue onto the reverse of each handprint, before placing them in position and gently pressing them down.
