

	WEEK BEGINNING 15TH MARCH 2021 TOPIC - GROWING
Daily Wake and Shake	Start everyday with this wake and shake Boogie Beebies Gardening- https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OnWG_uAy9lY&t=11s
Understanding the World	We are learning about growing this term. You will need a variety of seeds. Ask - where do plants come from? How do they grow? What do they need? Show them different types of seeds. Look at the differences. What do they notice is the same/different? Has anyone grown anything? Ask what do seeds/beans need to grow? If you have different seed, sort them in to size. Tell them they are going to do an experiment. Growing broad beans – Put some broad bean in a zip-lock food bag with wet cotton wool/kitchen towel and stick it on the window. Take photos of the changes. Discuss what will happen, note predictions. Observe what happens to the seed over the days. Ensure that the kitchen towel does not dry out.
Reading	Continue to read a variety of books from the oxford owl website and Bug Club. https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/reading/free-ebooks/ Bug Club - https://www.activelearnprimary.co.uk/login?c=0 Make sure you are reading books and stories every day. Find sight words in the book. Can you draw a picture about the story you have read and write a sentence about it.
Shared Reading	Story “ Jaspers Beanstalk” https://www.slideshare.net/MarAbellnBallesteros/jaspers-beanstalk1 Use the reading strategies as you read the book. Look at the letters, make the sounds and blend the sounds together. Or, Look at the first letters, make the sound and cross check with the picture. Monday- Read sight words ‘for’ ‘he’ ‘said’ ‘and’. • Read page 2. Stop at the word ‘bean’ and segment and blend. • Page 5 - discuss the words ‘raked’ and ‘hoed’. Ensure they know what it means. • Page 6 - Stop at the words ‘night’ and ‘snails’ segment and blend • Page 8 – segment and blend ‘waited’. Why has the word waited been written 3 times? • Read to page 10 and discuss inverted commas (it is direct speech so read with expression). Ask your child to join in a disappointed voice. • Read to the end of the book. Tuesday – Read sight words ‘for’ ‘he’ ‘said’ ‘and’. Practise saying the days of the week. Ask what day comes before/after a picked day. Look for sight words in the story. Ask key questions. • Which day did Jasper find the bean? Find the word page 2 • What did Jasper do on Tuesday? Find the sentence – page 3 • Why did Jasper pick up all the slugs and snails? Page 6 • Why was Jasper upset on Sunday?

	What did Jasper need to do for the beanstalk to grow? Wednesday - Read sight words 'for' 'he' 'said' 'and'. Read through the book again.
Writing	Thursday- Remind your child of the writing strategy – say the word, robot the word, write word. Remind them of capital letters, finger spaces and full stop. Help them write the sentence – 'Jasper planted a seed.' Use the alphabet mat provided in the previous learning pack to help your child write their sentence.
Handwriting	Friday - Continue to practise forming and writing your phonics sounds <i>s a t p i n m d g o c k c k e u r h b l f l l s s j v w x y z z z c h s h t h n g a y e e i g h o a</i>
Phonics	Click on the link to watch the videos that are needed for your child over the week . Work at your child's pace. Maths	Monday Starter – Number flashcards – show numbers to recognise 2D shapes PPT – Go through properties of shapes in PPT. Then Go through second PPT – guess the shape game – give each child a one 2D shape. VOCAB - , circle, square, rectangle, hexagon, triangle, sides, edges, corners, curved, straight. Tuesday- Starter-. Number flashcards. What is one less than a given number? 3D shapes PPT – Go through properties of shapes. Go through everyday shapes PPT. Ask your child to find things at home that are 3D shapes. VOCAB - cube, cuboid, sphere, cone, square based pyramid, faces, corners, edges, sides, curved edge. Wednesday - Starter- Missing numbers using large number line. https://www.topmarks.co.uk/ordering-and-sequencing/shape-patterns shape patterns. VOCAB - pattern, repeating, next, continue, same, match, shape names. Thursday- Starter- Counting forwards and backwards from a given number to 20 Addition to 10 - have unifix 10 counters. Separate the counters into 2 parts. Demonstrate simple addition to 10. VOCAB Addition , add, plus, altogether Friday – Starter – Number flashcards & Shape flashcards Subtraction to 10 – Use dried beans or seeds - tell number stories. I have 10 seeds, a bird flew down and ate 3. How many left? Show how to do sum practically. VOCAB Subtraction , take away, less, how many, left.
