Understanding the World	Zoo Animals What kind of animals did the zoo send? Wild animals. What is a zoo? What type of animals can you find in the zoo? Who looks after the animals in the zoo? Discuss hunting and shelter etc. Discuss what camouflage means why do they need to hide? Reading	Continue to read a variety of books from the oxford owl website and Bug Club. https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/reading/free-ebooks/ Bug Club - https://www.activelearnprimary.co.uk/login?c=0 Make sure you are reading books and stories every day. Find sight words in the book. Can you draw a picture about the story you have read and write a sentence about it.
Shared Reading	<u>Monday</u> Use the reading strategies as you read the book. Look at the letters, make the sounds and blend the sounds together. Or, Look at the first letters, make the sound and cross check with the picture. Encourage the children to read the story Walking Through The Jungle by Julie Lacome https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=tKPJbuP0g04 Read the title - Walking through the Jungle What animals do you think you will see in the book? ‘I think I will see....’ What was the first animal the boy saw? Find the word snake What did the boy see when the boy was creeping through the jungle? Find the word tiger. What sound did the monkey make? Find the words chitter chatter. <u>Tuesday</u> Re-read the story and join in with the actions – walking, creeping, leaping, running... <u>Wednesday</u> Pause the video and find sight words – you, for, the
Writing	<u>Thursday</u> Remind your child of the writing strategy – say the word, robot the word, write word. Remind them of capital letters, finger spaces and full stop. Help your child to write some facts about animals. ‘A zebra has black and white stripes. It lives in..... and eats.....’ Extend sentences by adding adjectives (sharp white teeth, long trunk) Use the alphabet mat provided in the previous learning pack to help your child write their sentence Friday – write a list of adjectives to describe an animal of your choice.

Maths	Monday Starter – What is one more than a given number? Main – look at the powerpoint and talk about the different coins. 1p,2p,5p,10p,20p What do you notice? What is the same? What is different? Talk about the shape, colour, size etc Order the coins from smallest to biggest ensuring your child is saying pence Watch - Money ordering song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=dFzAU3u06Ps VOCAB – coins, pence pennies, value, same as, buy Tuesday Starter – sing 5 currant buns https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=w2s7gnaL5rl Main – I want to buy some things from the shop. Can you help me pay for them? Have some items with prices on them. Give your child coins (1p) to pay for the items. Discuss that sometimes there are lot of different ways you can make the same amount. Not always 1 way. VOCAB – price, pennies, buy Wednesday- Starter- Count forwards and backwards from a number Main- Find different ways of making numbers up to 10p.
