

	WEEK BEGINNING 7 th June 2021 Topic –Den Building/The Three Little Pigs
Daily Wake and Shake	Start everyday with this wake and shake Boogie Beebies – Building https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1lCxoIcruCU Boogie Beebies – Dig It https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Mw0C0ybhqTo Build my house song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7psIPkjaQnk
Understanding the World	This week we are learning about building houses and dens. We are also thinking about the houses that the Three Little Pigs built and the materials they used. Go outside, use bamboo canes, poles, clips, fabric to make a den in the playground near the pirate ship. Tell them they are going to make a house for the pigs. Let them make labels to say keep out or they could make a list of things they have used. <u>The 3 Pigs Houses</u> Discuss the material that the pigs made their houses out of. Which one was the best material? Make houses from different materials and use a hairdryer to blow them down. Which house was the best? Why? How could you improve the house?
Reading	Read the story of the 3 Little pigs. Ask then where, who, what and why questions about the story. Read alternative stories about the Pigs The 3 little wolves and the big bad pig - https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=qPW9VUm299I The True Story of the Big Bad Wolf - https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=vB07RfntTvw Continue to read a variety of books from the oxford owl website and Bug Club. https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/reading/free-ebooks/ Bug Club - https://www.activelearnprimary.co.uk/login?c=0 Make sure you are reading books and stories every day. Find sight words in the book. Can you draw a picture about the story you have read and write a sentence about it.
Writing	Encourage children to write a list of materials that they would use to make a house. Write labels for the houses and den that they have built. They could write keep out labels..
Handwriting	Friday - Continue to practise forming and writing your phonics sounds s a t p i n m d g o c k c k e u r h b f l f f s s j v w x y z z z ch sh th ng ay ee igh oa oo ar, ur, or, er, ur, air.
Phonics	Assess all the sounds learnt so far (above) and then revise the sounds that your child is unsure of for the rest of the week. Read and write words/sentences using those sounds.
Maths	Monday – 1 more and 1 less When we are counting one more- What will happen to the number? How much will the number get bigger by? If I do one less, what happens to the number? (go back one/ the number gets smaller by 1). Show this on the number line. Play the game - Listen to the question and ask children to come and answer. Use a number line to support. Use the toggle at the top to do numbers up to 20. https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/beeMoreOrLess/ Tuesday and Wednesday – Number stories - Tell children an addition number story using the link below. Use the words first, then and now. https://content.connect.collins.co.uk/Content/Live/ElektraMedia/Busy_ants/Foundation/GamesandTools/30_IMT_Tree/index.html First there were 4 birds on a tree. Then 3 more birds came along. Now there are 7 birds altogether. What did I have to do to work out there were 7 birds? Did my number get bigger or smaller? Why did my number get bigger and not smaller? Then do another example. But just say the words. First, Then and Now and get the children to tell you the addition number story. E.g. say “first” (then move 5 cats on the grass). Say “then” (move 3 monkeys onto the grass). Say “Now” and hover the mouse over them all. What is my number story? Repeat with other examples.

	Thursday – 2D and 3D shapes – find objects around the house that are 2D and 3D. Now sort them into groups. What does 2D mean? What does 3D mean? Describe the properties of the shapes. Friday – continue with 2D and 3D shapes. Use the link and go through the quiz on 3D shapes https://www.iknowit.com/lessons/k-geometry-solid-shapes-3d.html Ask questions along the way. e.g. How did you know this was a cone? How many faces does this shape have? Why can this shape not be a cone? Etc..
Personal, Social, Emotional Development	Talk about how your child felt when they first started the Reception class at the beginning of the academic year. What do they like about the class? What do they not enjoy? Who are their friends? What has helped you?
Creative & Music	Create models of the 3 pigs' houses using different materials. Make dens inside and outside. Build my house song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7psIPkjaQnk
Physical Activity	Dough Disco- Using playdough, ask your child to follow the moves on "Dough Disco" https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3K-CQrjI0uY Throwing, catching and kicking a soft ball with your child. Handwriting practice – make sure your child is forming the letters correctly.
