

	WEEK BEGINNING 14 th June 2021 Topic – RE Theme Day Inspirational People
Daily Wake and Shake	Start everyday with this wake and shake Wake and Shake – Boogie Beebies – Sporty 2 https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hvHrjab6f2c
Understanding the World	This week we are learning about People who inspire us. Talk about what inspire means – someone who encourages them to be the best, someone who has worked really hard to achieve something difficult or done something brave through difficult times. Ask them who that person is. It should be someone that they know and are familiar with. Help them to draw a picture and write about that person and why they inspire them. We will also be talking about Father's Day. Show them the Twinkl PPT about Father's Day. Talk about why their dad is special and he does. How can they say thank you to their dads? Make a card for their dad. Do jobs for their dad, make them feel special.
Reading	Poetry Read the poem about Father's Day. During the week try to see if you can read lots of poems and rhymes with your child. Discuss rhyming words.
Writing	Write about their inspirational person. Write a list of rhyming words.
Handwriting	Friday - Continue to practise forming and writing your phonics sounds s a t p i n m d g o c k c k e u r h b f l f f s s j v w x y z z z ch sh th ng ay ee igh oa oo ar, ur, or, er, ur, air, ear
Phonics	Assess all the sounds learnt so far (above) and then revise the sounds that your child is unsure of for the rest of the week. Read and write words/sentences using those sounds.
Maths	Monday – Go through the PPT with your child – Say - I bought a shirt for father's day. It had 9 buttons But then 4 fell off (move 4 buttons) How many buttons are left on the shirt? How can we work out the answer? What do we need to do first? To work out the answer what do I now have to do? How can I write this as a number sentence? How many buttons did I have first? Then how many fell? How many were left? Continue with the PPT. Tuesday and Wednesday – Continue using objects to make subtraction stories. Encourage them to write number sentences, but make sure they are able to explain the process that they used. Can they count back to work out the answer or can they use a number line to help them? Thursday – show the shape section on the PPT – 3D shapes . Look through the PPT and ask them what 3D shapes they can see. Friday – continue with 3D shapes. Go on a 3D shape hunt. Make sure they can describe the properties of the shapes – faces, edges, corners, curved, flat, etc.
Personal, Social, Emotional Development	Talk about moving on to year 1. What do they think they need to know to be ready for year 1? Talk about feelings. Are they nervous or excited?
Creative & Music	Create a Father's Day card. Make own design, use different medium – cutting, sticking, painting, drawing, etc.
Physical Activity	Dough Disco- Using playdough, ask your child to follow the moves on "Dough Disco" https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3K-CQrjI0uY

	Throwing, catching and kicking a soft ball with your child. Handwriting practice – make sure your child is forming the letters correctly.
