Monday 1st March 2021

ENGLISH: This week we are starting fiction topic and the book we are focusing on is called Cops and Robbers. Click on the link to listen to Mrs Sheikh's shared reading lesson.

SPELLINGS - Practise spellings for test next week. The 'ou' sound can be spelt 'ou' (house) or 'ow' (now). If the 'ou' sound comes at the end of the word, then the spelling will be -ow.

PHONICS: Follow the link for your phonics lesson today on the 'ch (ture)' sound. The links for this week's phonics videos will be on J2E so have a look in the folders for each day.

Remember to write down all of your learning in your remote learning books and send a picture to your class teacher on J2E.

BREAK

MATHS: Today we are recapping adding using a number line. You have a powerpoint called adding on a number line which you need to open and go through each slide. Each group has a range of addition questions to answer using the number lines from the pack. We are working on using the number line strategy today. Red group- You can write the numbers on the number line and use the number line on the worksheet to add the numbers together. A number line has been added to the pack for you to be able to use when completing the addition number sentences. Blue group- You can write the numbers on the number line and use the number line on the worksheet to add the numbers together. A number line has been added to the pack for you to be able to use when completing the addition number sentences. Green group- Complete the addition number sentences using the number lines from the pack to help you.

LUNCH

READING: Find the reading racetrack on J2E or in your packs. Remember, when you read for 15 minutes or more to get one of your racetracks signed. Let's see which class is going to be the winning class! You need to send a picture of your completed racetrack back to your teacher! Read one of your bug club books for this week. Write a summary of your book to sum up the main events.

SCIENCE: This week we are going to be looking at the difference between an object and the materials it is made from. Go through the PowerPoint and click on the clips to listen to the instructions.

Activity one - Cut out the pictures on the picture cards work sheet and match them with the correct material. Alternatively, you can complete the worksheet 2A (Green group) - Look around your house and find objects to match the materials. 2B (Blue group) - Look around your house and find objects made out of the two materials. 2C - (red group) Write a list of objects made out of each material. **Challenge** - Why do you think babies bowls and spoons are made from plastic? Think about the cutlery we use to eat with and why it is different. Write down your explanation in your remote learning books.

ASSEMBLY: Find the 'what is fair-trade' PowerPoint on J2E. Have a read through what fair-trade is and have a look in your house to see if you have any fair-trade products.

Tuesday 2nd March 2021

ENGLISH: Listen to the story of cops and robbers by clicking on the link.

Activity 1 - To complete a character description on the three characters on the worksheet.

Challenge yourself to complete a character description on another character.

PHONICS: Follow the link for your phonics lesson today on the 'ch (tch)' sound. Remember to write down all of your learning in your remote learning books and send a picture to your class teacher on J2E.

BREAK

MATHS: We are continuing with adding today using a number line. There is number lines for each group included in the packs for you to use for today's activities.

Red group- Read the addition flashcards and answer the questions using the number lines to help you. Don't forget to show the jumps on your number line.

Blue group- Read the addition flashcards and answer the questions using the number lines to help you. Don't forget to show the jumps on your number line.

Green group- Use the number lines to answer the addition number sentences. Don't forget to show the jumps on your number line.

MENTAL MATHS: Next week's test will be based on ordering numbers from the smallest to the largest. Green group will order numbers up to 20. Blue group will order numbers to 50 and Red group will order numbers to 100. The test will take place on 08.03.21.

LUNCH

READING: Pick a book that you enjoy reading. Write a letter to the author of your book. Tell them what you think of their book and any questions that you would want them to answer. You could even ask them what it is like to be an author.

PE: We are carrying on with our ball skills lessons. You are going to need a ball and a clear space for today's lesson. Follow the instructions on the PowerPoint to complete the PE lesson.

The health work is at the end of the PowerPoint. Remember to write down your answers in full sentences into your remote learning books.

Wednesday 3rd March 2021

ENGLISH: Today we are going to plan our writing. Our writing task for this week is to rewrite the story in order. Look at the English planning worksheet and fill in the correct information from the book. Try and challenge yourself to think of another ending to the story or change the problem. Be creative!

PHONICS: Follow the link for your phonics lesson today on the 'j (dge)' sound. Remember to write down all of your learning in your remote learning books and send a picture to your class teacher on J2E.

HANDWRITING PRACTICE: Practise writing the next letter (d) in your new handwriting booklet. Try and think of words with these letter in and then write a list of words in cursive handwriting into your remote learning books.

BREAK

MATHS: Today we are going to be subtracting using a number line. We are using the skills we have practised to help us add on a number line to help us **subtract** using a number line. You need to go through the power point 'Subtraction power point' and go through the slides.

Red group- Use the number lines from yesterday to complete the subtraction number sentences. Don't forget to show your jumps on the number line.

Blue group- Use the number lines from yesterday to complete the subtraction number sentences. Don't forget to show your jumps on the number line.

Green group- Use the number lines on the worksheet to complete the subtraction number sentences. Don't forget to show your jumps on the number line so I can see your workings out.

LUNCH

READING – Pick a story book to read. Draw a picture of your favourite part of the book. Write what is happening in the picture and say why you chose this bit of the book.

CREATIVITY: We are going to carry on with our geography topic about the UK. Find the 'UK - Scotland' PDF, go through the slides and answer questions in your remote learning books.

Activity 1: Decorate the Scottish flag and/or design your own tartan fabric. Be as creative as you like!

Activity 2: Make some Scottish shortbread. Follow the recipe to make some yummy shortbread.

Thursday 4th March 2021

ENGLISH: Today we are going to write the story of Cops and Robbers. It may be a good idea to use the puppets and act out the story to help you remember.

PHONICS: Follow the link for your phonics lesson today on the 'm (mb)' sound. Remember to write down all of your learning in your remote learning books and send a picture to your class teacher on J2E.

BREAK

MATHS: We are continuing with adding using a number line. You can recap yesterday's subtraction powerpoint to help you remember how to subtract correctly using a number line.

Red group- Use the number lines on your worksheet to **draw the jumps** and complete the subtraction number sentences.

Blue group- Using the number lines from the beginning of the week complete the subtraction number sentences. Don't forget to draw the jumps as well as your answers.

Green group- Using the number lines from the beginning of the week complete the subtraction number sentences. Don't forget to draw the jumps as well as your answers.

READING: Log onto bug club and read one of your bug club books. Write down three questions you would ask someone to check they have read the book carefully.
