Monday 14th June 2021

- **ENGLISH:** *What do the aliens do during the day?* Reread *Man on the Moon*, looking for aliens in each illustration. Encourage inferences about events from the aliens' point of view.
- Page 10: *They are looking at planet Earth. I wonder what they're saying. What do they want to do?*
- *What do you think the aliens eat? Let's look for clues.*
- Use **Teacher in Role** to model imagining what the aliens might be saying or thinking in some scenes. Involve the children in improvising further things the aliens might say or think, drawing inferences from the illustrations.
- Show 'The aliens' day' ([FITP 1.3.4](#)). Model composing and writing a simple sentence about what the aliens are doing, based on ideas from your improvised conversation in role as an alien.

SPELLINGS & MENTAL MATHS

Activity 1 - Complete your spellings and mental maths test from last week (adding and subtracting money).

Activity 2 - Next week there will be no mental maths test as we have set half term homework instead. You have two tasks to complete over the half term holiday. First you need to take a walk or research your local area and make a poster or booklet on what you have found. Secondly you have the next 15 Year 1 common exception words that you will be tested on, when you come back to school on Monday 7th June. You need to be able to read the words confidently and use them in saying and writing a sentence.

PHONICS: Use the PowerPoint on the school website for the phonics lesson today on the 'wr', sound. Remember to write down all of your learning in your remote learning books and send a picture to your class teacher on J2E.

BREAK

MATHS: Today in maths we are going to be looking at addition and subtraction vocabulary. Use the word mats to create your own addition and subtraction vocabulary poster.

LUNCH

READING: Find the reading racetrack on J2E or in your packs. Remember, when you read for 15 minutes or more to get one of your racetracks signed. Let's see which class is going to be the winning class! You need to send a picture of your completed racetrack back to your teacher!

Read one of your bug club books for this week. Write a summary of your book to sum up the main events.

SCIENCE: Today we will be explaining how a seed grows into a plant. Look at the short video showing the steps it takes for a plant to grow and see if you can explain it to your partner.

Activity one - Make your own seed wheel. Red group - to draw and write, Blue group to write steps and green group to colour and explain.

Tuesday 15th June 2021

- **ENGLISH:** Today we are going to look another book called Dougal's Deep sea diary. Introduce the book by looking at the video. Show 'Sea life' ([F ITP 1.3.5](#)) and discuss both sections of the video. *What lives here? Why is it light/dark? What are the goggles for?* Start a word bank on the [Learning Wall](#).
- Shared read to page 13.
- Read *Dougal's Deep-Sea Diary* to page 13.
- Pages 2-3: *Which person in the picture is telling the story? How is he different?*
- Pages 4-5: *Anything unusual in this picture?*
- Pages 6-7: *'I don't usually see anything much.'* Who does that remind you of? (Bob) Explain vocabulary: 'harbour', 'rickety'.
- Pages 8-9: Support inference: *Which dolphin is Herbert? Do the sharks really want the salad?*
- Pages 10-11: *What was he bumping into?* Explain the pun: 'nippy'.
- Pages 12-13: *Was it raining?*

PHONICS: Use the PowerPoint on the school website for the phonics lesson today on the 'kn' sound. Remember to write down all of your learning in your remote learning books and send a picture to your class teacher on J2E. BREAK

MATHS: Today in maths we are going to be adding in 10's to 2-digit numbers using a 100 square. Go through the powerpoint adding in 10's to 2-digit numbers. Read the addition number sentences and use the 100 square to help you add in 10's to work out your answer.

LUNCH

READING: Pick a book that you enjoy reading. Think of a question you would write to the author of the book.

PE: PE with Joe Wicks. Just dance or cosmic kids yoga on YouTube. Follow the link to the Oak Academy PE lesson, you will be learning about what your body does when you move.

Wednesday 16th June 2021

- **ENGLISH:** Reread pages 2-15 of *Dougal's Deep-Sea Diary*, making sure you read the days of the week each time. Encourage them to notice what happens on each day.
- Look at 'Dougal's calendar' ([F ITP 1.3.6](#)). Can you drag the sentences into place?
- Organise six groups and allocate a day (Wednesday to Monday) to each group.
Activity: Write sentences on whiteboards to describe what Dougal does on each day.

PHONICS: Use the PowerPoint on the school website for the phonics lesson today on the 'i', sound. Remember to write down all of your learning in your remote learning books and send a picture to your class teacher on J2E.

HANDWRITING PRACTICE: Practise writing the next letter in your new handwriting booklet. Try and think of words with these letter in and then write a list of words in cursive handwriting into your remote learning books.

BREAK

MATHS: Today in maths we are going to be subtracting in 10's to 2-digit numbers using a 100 square. Go through the powerpoint adding and subtracting in 10's to 2-digit numbers. Read the subtraction number sentences and use the 100 square to help you add in 10's to work out your answer.

LUNCH

READING – Pick a story book to read. Draw a picture of your favourite part of the book. Write what is happening in the picture and say why you chose this bit of the book.

CREATIVITY: Take a walk around your local area. Look at what you can see on your walk. Take some pictures or you can draw what you have seen. See if you can notice any plants or trees that we have learnt about in science.

Thursday 17th June 2021

- **ENGLISH:** To write an explanation text on how a seed grows. Use the seed wheel to help you.

PHONICS: Use the PowerPoint on the school website for the phonics lesson today on the 'are', sound. Remember to write down all of your learning in your remote learning books and send a picture to your class teacher on J2E. BREAK

MATHS: Today you are going to be practising adding and subtracting. Play the space race game and follow the instructions to practise adding and subtracting in 10's.

LUNCH

READING: Log onto bug club and read one of your bug club books. Write down three questions you would ask someone to check they have read the book carefully.

Write down the matching addition or subtraction number sentence for the word problem so that we know that you have understood the question.
