



Year 2 Remote Learning

Hello Year 2,

We are sorry we will not be seeing you today, but we have set you some fun and exciting work to do at home! This work can be done with an adult but we would like you to try to do some independently if you can.

Activity 1- Read your school book, or any other book you have at home. You will need to choose a fiction book to then complete the book review. If you do not have access to a printer, then write the review on a piece of paper. Remember to write in full sentences and use neat cursive handwriting.

Activity 2- For the writing activity you are looking at the picture and describing what you see in full sentences using capital letters and full stops. We have also provided you with some interesting vocabulary (writing activity adjectives) to help you with this. If you want to be creative you can turn it into a story.

Activity 3- For this activity you are going on a 2D shape hunt around your house. You are free to choose whether you would like to draw what you find, or complete the tally. Once you have completed the hunt, write down the properties of the 2D shapes you find (side and vertices). As an extension, try this with 3D shapes (sphere, cuboid, cylinder, cube and cone). Vocabulary you will need to use are faces, edges and vertices.

Activity 4- Time to get creative! Make a picture/model of a form of transport that could take you to the moon. You can use the shapes from activity 3, your toys (e.g. building blocks, playdough), things from your recycling box (please ask an adult) and any other imaginative way you can think of.
